

What is Crazy 8s?

- 1 Rapid Sketching8 ideas in 8 minutes!
- **3** Fast Idea Generation Quantity breeds quality.
- 2 Intense Focus
 Time-boxed creativity.
- 4 Forced creativity

 Breaks thinking patterns.


