1 Rapid Sketching

8 ideas in 8 minutes!

3 Fast Idea Generation

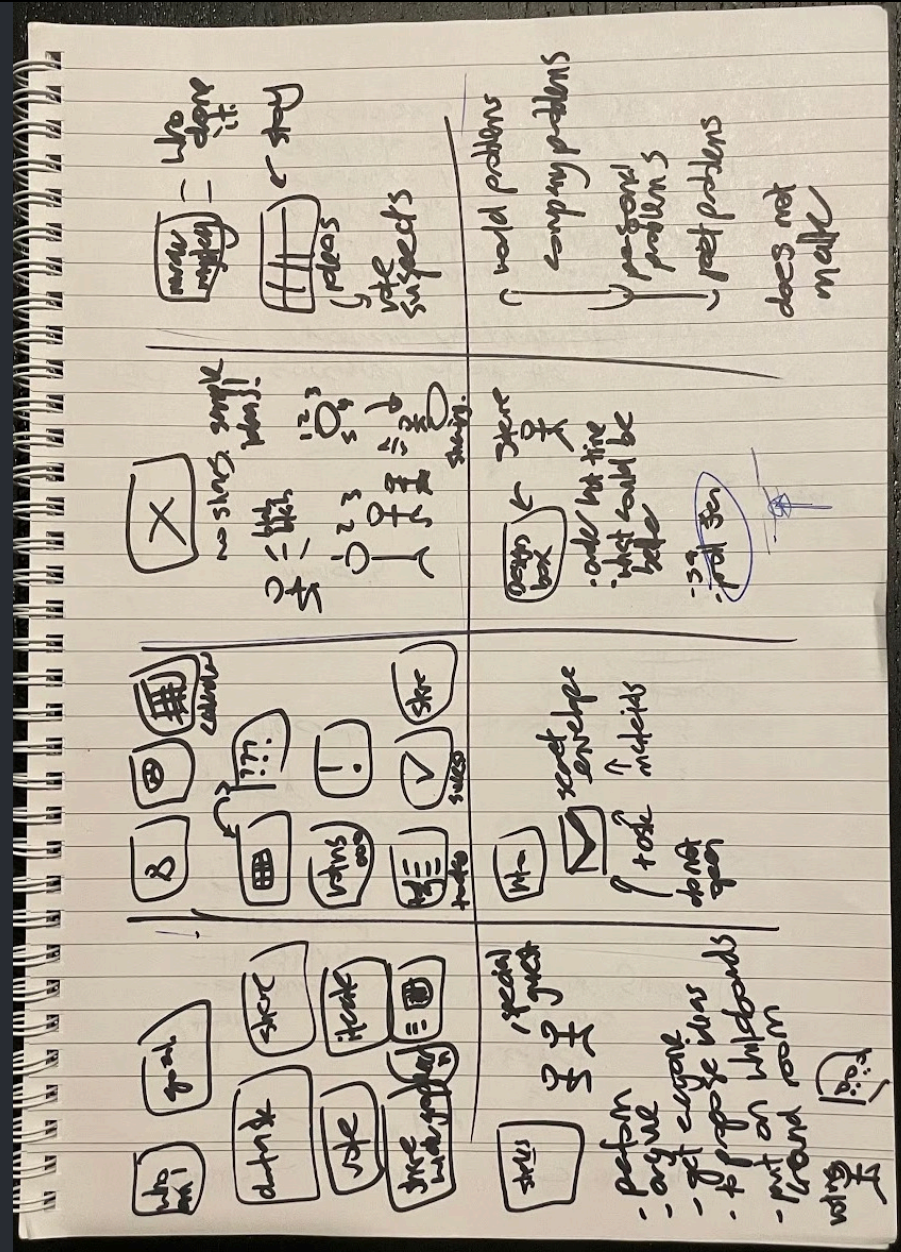
Quantity breeds quality.

2 Intense Focus

Time-boxed creativity.

4 Forced creativity

Breaks thinking patterns.

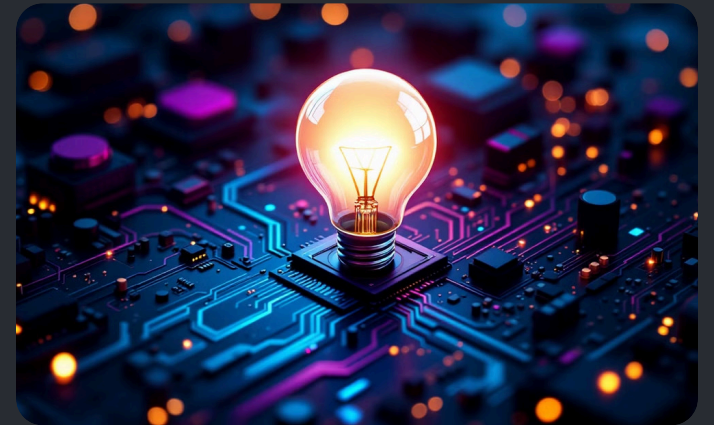
Start the Clock

Quick drawings, no perfect art needed.



Idea Generation

Unleash creativity, brainstorm freely.
Work by yourself
